## Block of the Month for September



GQG BOM

August, 2017  
Due: September, 2017

### GRECIAN SQUARE

You can find this block in the September/October 2016 issue of McCall's Quilting magazine. The pattern is called "Crossing Paths", page 7

It takes about 1 hour to make one block measuring 12 1/4 inches square

This block uses 2 contrasting prints against a white background. Fabrics can be contrasting prints or contrasting solid colours. *FABRICS A AND B*

- Cut four of Fabric A 2 5/8 by 4 1/4
  - Cut four of Fabric B 2 5/8 by 4 1/4
  - Cut one white 7 1/4 inch square in half twice diagonally
  - Cut two white 3 7/8 inch square in half once diagonally
- Fabric A - cut 1 - 4 1/4 square  for center*

Referring to Diagram 1, sew 2 contrasting print rectangles to make one unit.



DIAGRAM 1

Referring to Diagram 2, sew together 4 matching units, 1 corresponding print square, 4 white 7 1/4 "quarter-square triangles and 4 3 7/8 "half-square triangles to make Grecian Square Block.

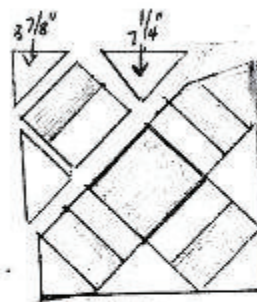
