

## Happy Hearts Quilt Block

Block size: 12 1/2" unfinished

Colors: assorted pinks and reds

Blocks can be constructed using 2 shades of red or pink and the same 2 shades opposite in bottom quadrants.

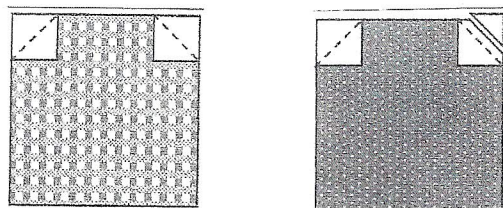
### Cutting instructions:

Color 1    cut 1    6 1/2" square  
              cut 1    6 7/8" square

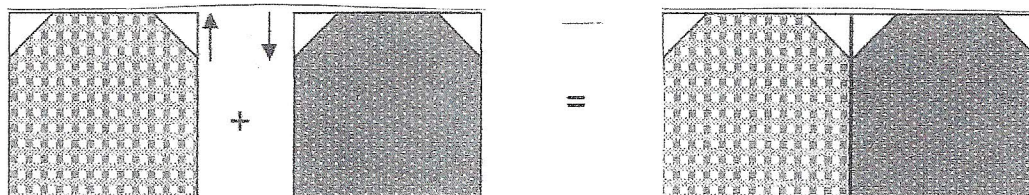
Color 2    cut 1    6 1/2" square  
              cut 1    6 7/8" square

White on white    cut 4    2 1/2" squares  
                          cut 2    6 7/8" squares

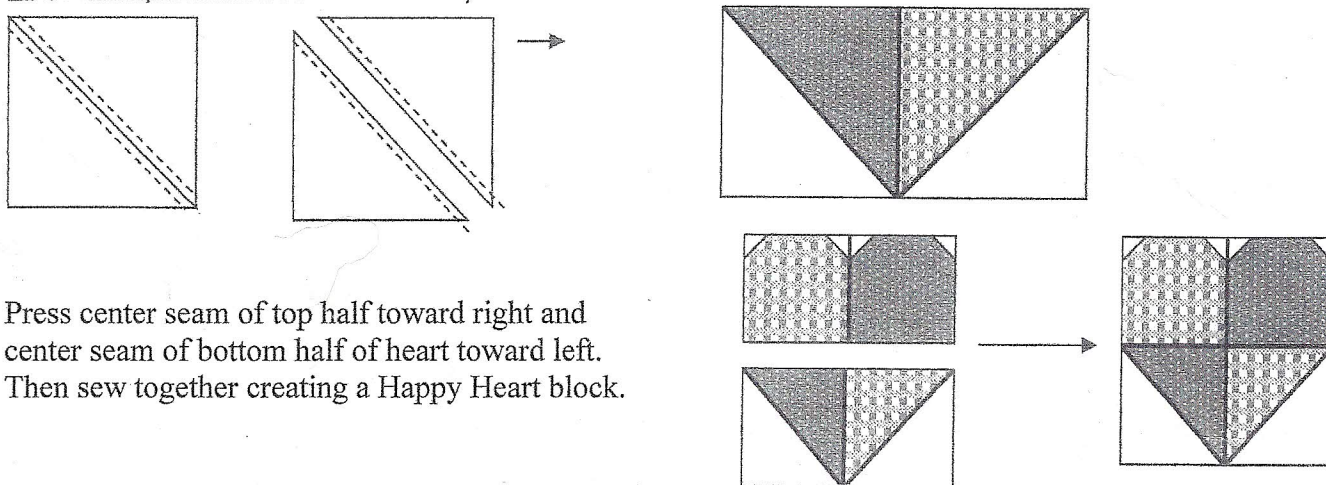
1. With right sides together, place white 2 1/2" squares on the upper corners of the two 6 1/2" squares. Draw a line from corner to corner as pictured and sew on that line. Then cut off each corner 1/4" from seam.



2. Press one center corner seam up and one down for perfect center points. Sew the two squares together. Press.



3. Place a 6 7/8" white square and a 6 7/8" colored square right sides together and draw a pencil line from corner to corner and sew 1/4" on each side of the pencil line. Cut on pencil line. Open and press one toward the dark and one toward the light for perfect points when sewn. Then sew the 2 red/white squares together as pictured. (Make 2 sets of half-square triangles using two different prints. ( This will make 4 half-square triangles. Save the extra two squares for another block.)



4. Press center seam of top half toward right and center seam of bottom half of heart toward left. Then sew together creating a Happy Heart block.
