

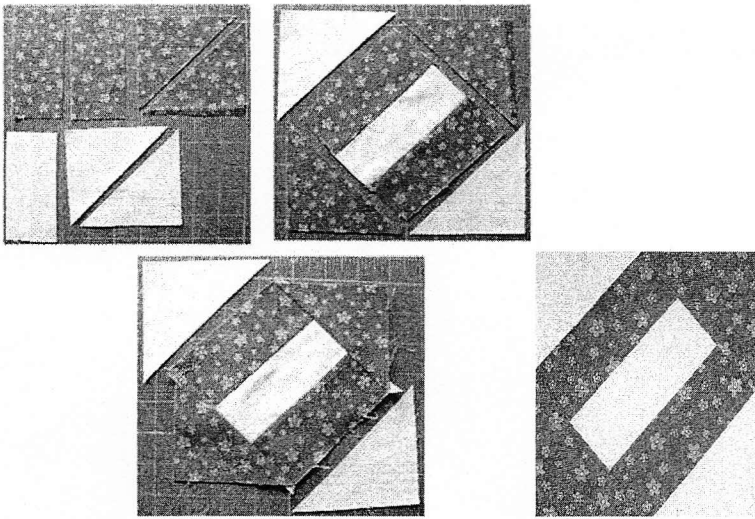
## Cracker Block

### From 30's fabric, cut:

- One 4" square, then cut it in half to make 2 triangles
- Two 2" x 4-1/2" strips

### From the white on white fabric, cut:

- One 4" square, then cut in half to make 2 triangles
- One 2" x 4-1/2" strip



Sew the three bars together lengthwise, with the white on white strip in the middle. Press the seam allowances towards the 30's bars. The finished unit should measure 4 1/2 inches square.

Center and sew a 30's triangle to the bar unit, arranging it to flow across a side with seams as shown. Press the seam allowance towards the triangle. Repeat on the opposite side.

Center and sew a white triangle to the remaining sides. Press the seam allowances towards the pieced bar unit.

Your Cracker quilt block should measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2". If it doesn't, check to make sure your strips were cut to the correct width. If your block is slightly smaller, try sewing the next block with a scant 1/4" seam allowance

Use a FABRIC pen and sign your name across the center of the white strip. Do NOT use a Sharpie or normal ink pen as they will bleed when washed.

If you want to make more than 1 block write a quilty quote or saying in the other block.
